## RESOLUTION NO. 2023-6-15 DISPOSITION OF SALVAGE OR SURPLUS PROPERTY

WHEREAS, as authorized by Texas Local Government Code Chapter 51, the City of China, Texas ("City") has the power to "take, hold, lease, grant, or convey" property;

WHEREAS, the City desires to declare certain personal property as salvage as that term is defined in the Texas Local Government Code;

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that such salvage property may be given to ESD #3 for training purposes or may be disposed of accordingly.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHINA, TEXAS:

The city has replaced a broken fire hydrant. The broken fire hydrant has no value for the purpose for which it was originally intended and has been declared salvage property. EDC #3 has requested the broken fire hydrant to use for training purposes. The City Secretary is authorized to give the salvage property to EDC #3, or in the alternative if EDC #3 no longer desires to use the salvage property, the City Secretary is authorized to dispose of the property accordingly.
